

Dear Vice Presidents,

The league campaign has finally drawn to a close, with Sarries achieving an excellent top-half finish of 5<sup>th</sup> place in the league. Sarries finished the season extremely strongly, with 6 wins and 3 losses from our last 9 games, but with fantastic performances and effort from everyone in all the matches. Sarries beat Cooper Avon II 36-17 to record our 2<sup>nd</sup> league double of the season, where I was also extremely happy to touch down my 1<sup>st</sup> try (and only try) of the season. This game was followed by back-to-back games against promotion-chasing Colerne. Away we were defeated 16-0, but at home Sarries produced an exceptional performance to walk away 16-12 winners. Sarries form continued into the next two matches with wins against Chippenham III and Pewsey Vale. We lost a very close game at home to promotion-hopefuls Devizes II, there was nothing in the match, and Sarries performance deserved more, but we succumbed to a 7-0 defeat. Sarries entertained Swindon College at home, and although dominated for large periods of the match we only won 5-0. We also recorded a good victory away in a friendly match to Old Morganians. Our last match of the season was against Sutton Benger, who needed victory to become Champions of the league. Unfortunately Sarries Flanker, Rich Pollhill suffered a double fracture in his leg, half way through the 1<sup>st</sup> half, and although Sarries rallied together to get a result for Rich, we lost 48-6 to an extremely well-drilled side. The team and players wishes of a speedy recovery go out to Rich, as I am sure you will too.


I hope that you all have an enjoyable close season, and I look forward to next season where the Sarries will be ready to embark on another exciting year!
